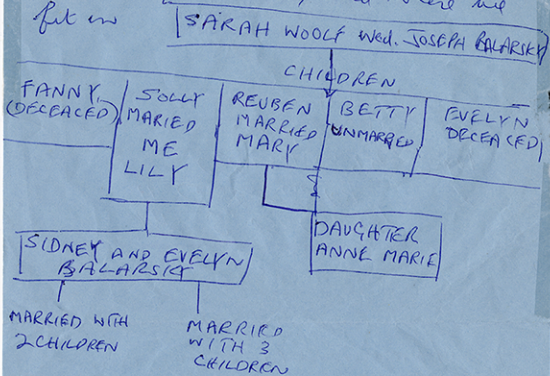


Dear Susan,
