Children Challenges, and Choices--A Workshop for Single Moms Planning For Tomorrow

(Workshop manual and leader's guide, 1991, 108 pp)

An exciting new workshop for single moms who are recipients of social assistance has just been developed by Womens' Career Resources and workshop manuals are now available. The pilots completed last year met with great success, and workshops conducted recently have been applauded for their relevance, sensitivity, and timeliness. Designed to provide the pre-career planning groundwork often needed by many single moms before more in-depth educational/occupational planning can begin, this workshop could serve as an important bridge to increased independence. Ideally it should be offered over three consecutive days with two modules being covered per day. The following six modules make up the workshop.

- This Is Where I Start
- Self-Esteem (Feeling Good About Myself)
- Communicating Clearly
- Am I Like Cinderella?
- Where Do I Go From Here?
- Managing My Life

The Workshop has been designed to allow participants to explore their own personal situations and circumstances in a safe understanding environment. It encourages participants to examine their own and society's expectations of them, and to challenge, within a supportive group setting, some of the common major barriers to independence experienced by this group. The workshop manuals that are now available provide detailed instructions and guidelines for facilitating the workshop.

It now includes only those courses and programs offered by post-secondary institutions, professional organizations and associations, and private vocational schools licensed or registered in the three prairie provinces--Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba.

Other changes to the publication include telephone numbers of the offering institutions, and the medium of instruction for each course (print, audio/visual, teleconferencing, radio/TV, or computer, etc.) Two important appendices have also been added--one listing all the complete or partial programs which can be taken through distance learning, and the other listing all correspondence directories providing distance education information for other parts of Canada. Addresses required for ordering them are also provided.
