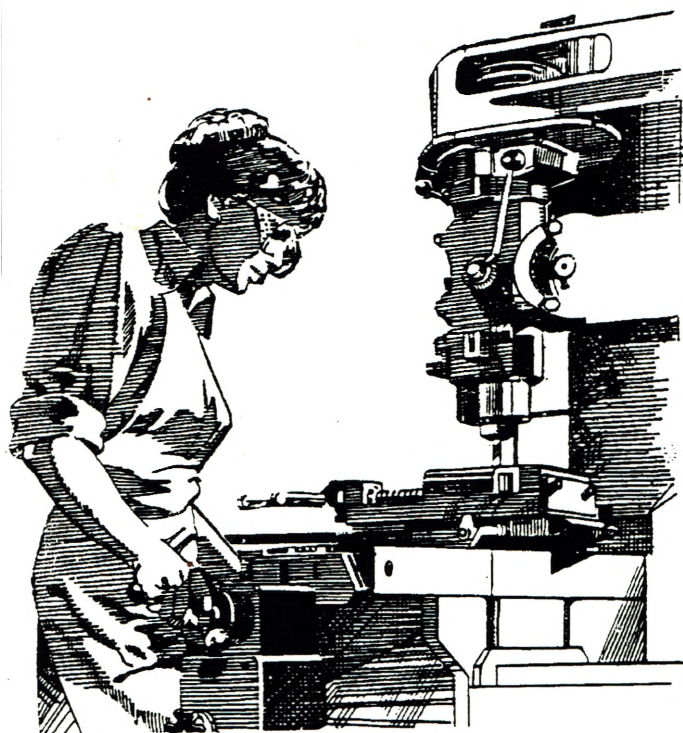


Women's Access to Apprenticeship Projects



Twenty-five community based Women's Access to Apprenticeship Projects are funded by the Ontario Training and Adjustment Board (OTAB), Apprenticeship and Client Services Branch. Five additional Projects are located in the Apprenticeship District Field Offices.

Locally based throughout the province, the Projects respond to individual market employment situations. They assist women seeking non-traditional apprenticeship opportunities by bringing together available support services in the community.

Women's Access to Apprenticeship is;

Locating and informing women interested in skilled occupations

Identifying employers and unions interested in training women as apprentices.

Assisting OTAB Industrial Training Consultants in matching apprentices with employers; and

Providing outreach activities to redress attitude and informational barriers to female participation in apprenticeship.
