Actually I tried a fresh Kittiwake by the method with a petrol colouerd red; it all came out quite well but I would hesitate to use a coloyred petrol on anything good. This particular bird was stale and very dirty and I did not much mind trying an exporiment. It was a bird found here in our district otherwise I should not have troubled to preserve it atall.

I havelooked out some skins for you during the past couple of days, these include I Buteo buteo buteo ad. this is as you doubtless know a very variable species, and the one I am sending you is a rather light phase.
